



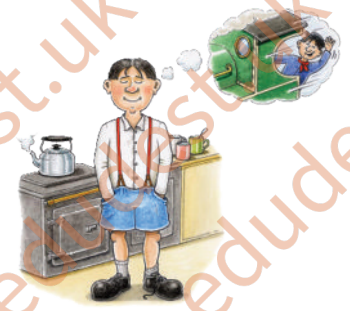
Staying Safe on the Railway
