FOLLOW-UP ACTIVITY

Writing - composition

Review and comment





Contextual Summary

This is an English writing (composition) task that enables students to practise their writing skills, specifically to review and to comment.

The task links to the students' visit to Dinosaur Isle and is relevant

The task links to the students' visit to Dinosaur Isle and is relevant to students in Key Stages 2 and 3. This task links the visit with core English writing/composition skills and allows students the opportunity to reflect on their learning and experience.

Task Implementation

This task can be introduced before the visit to the Dinosaur Isle museum, in class, by studying the features of reviews; students could practise a review on a local area or a holiday destination they've visited.

When on site, students could make notes on the key features of the museum and its exhibits to use in their review on returning to class.

Ability Levels

There are 2 versions of this resource, one for key stage 3 and one for key stage 2, generally adapted for mixed ability students. They could be further adapted by teachers if required, i.e. for SEN. For example, students could be shown and asked to write less detailed reviews, etc..

Learning Opportunities

Pre-Visit

Review and comment skills could be pre-taught in class prior to the trip so students are aware of the information they need to note during their visit.

During the Visit

Noting down features they may want to include in their review:

- ► What they can do here
- ► Things they learn
- ► How they enjoyed the features of the museum (expert talk, interactive exhibits, dinosaur models, fossil walk, etc.)
