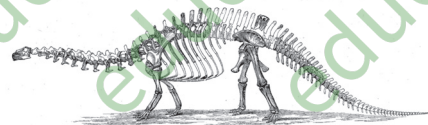
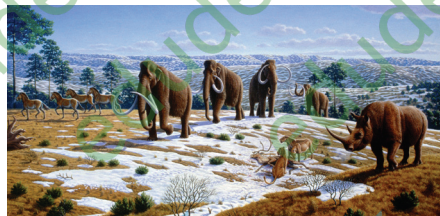
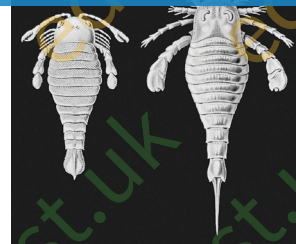


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- ✓ In fact, all of the images on page 1 show Palaeoart!
